SANJAY KISHAN KAUL, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

The petitioner, appearing in person, seeks to advance the cause of lady constables in the police stations as it is alleged that there is absence of lady toilets in police stations and police posts, the details of which he has obtained after serving notice on the respondents.

There is no doubt that adequate facilities in respect of the aforesaid are required. We would expect the Government to look into this issue expeditiously and the Director General of Police with the Department of Home Affairs to take necessary action for provision of toilets for lady constables in different police stations. We would also expect the action to be taken within a maximum period of four months from today.

The petition accordingly stands disposed of.
